Reach height with the Versa-Boom linkage has been increased by 10 percent—51.7 in. (7 ft. height, 45° dump) on the 321E—which is helpful when loading out trucks or filling hoppers. The longer reach also allows you to easily work from one side of a flat bed truck when unloading palletized material.

The single-lever loader control (forward-neutral-reverse joystick with transmission speed button) put all controls at your fingertips. The hydraulic steering and articulated frame deliver superior maneuverability.




