In contrast to specialist machines, STEYR forestry tractors are highly versatile and can be used for work outside the forest. Depending on the model, they are ideally suited to special uses. All models are perfect for hauling short and long logs, for use with logging wagons or winches, and for loading and transporting with polder loaders, cranes or trailers. Multi, Expert CVT, Profi, Profi CVT and CVT also have considerable potential for use in hedgerow and woodland management with forest mulchers, hedge trimmers and wood chippers. The STEYR Terrus CVT in particular, is an immensely powerful tool when it comes to wood chip production, i.e. in driving and feeding wood chippers.

Added safety

The brand is setting standards for safe forestry work with a tailored "protective suit" for all STEYR forestry tractors from 75 to 300 PS. The solid forestry protection frame 2.0 with branch deflector is certified according to ISO 8083, and is available straight from the factory in the familiar four or six-pillar design. With its customisable design, it offers the optimum in safety. Safety is provided by protective grilles on the roof and in front of the rear windscreen, a sturdy floor protection plate, as well as side panels to protect the engine, transmission, rear axle, in addition to the fuel tank and hydraulic fluid tank. The Multi, which is equipped with an optimised contour frame for the ultimate in safety and all-round vision, also comes with the option of a shatterproof Makrolon rear windscreen, tested and certified according to ISO 8084.

The rear view mirrors are detachable in all models, all of which feature movable steps. Large forestry tyres with reinforced forestry rims and valve protection in all models go the extra mile to ensure that these STEYR forestry specialists get the job done reliably and efficiently in any forestry environment. The ECOTECH concept also plays a key role in the superb efficiency of STEYR tractors: The technology reduces fuel consumption and harmful emissions – gentle on your pocket and on the environment.

Reverse-drive system for maximum operating convenience

Steyr offers a fully integrated reverse-drive system for models from the Profi through to the Terrus CVT, and for the 115 to 300 PS performance range. This is of real benefit to any customers who use logging wagons or wood mulchers. All controls here, including the armrest, can be switched in seconds from normal forward mode to reverse-drive mode, making work safer and less stressful. In the case of the Steyr Terrus CVT, the reverse-drive system has been available since November 2017, a further reason to choose the high-power Steyr flagship model. For customers who do not need a complete reverse-drive system, a simple rotating seat is also available; this can be turned right through 180° towards the rear to make it is much easier to work when reversing.

From "light to heavy"

Even though forestry work in general can be demanding, for forestry tractors, every job is different. This is why Steyr offers different forestry packages for the Compact and Multi models in "light", "light including side panel" and "heavy" versions. In the "light" forestry module, a continuous floor protection plate running up to the front axle and side guard for the engine and fuel tank provide basic protection in woodland. The "light including side panel" forestry module also includes side panels for engine, transmission, fuel tank, SCR Cat, right-hand battery bank, and movable steps.

In addition to these components, the "heavy" forestry module offers protection underneath the fuel tank, a 4-pillar forestry frame, a 12 mm Makrolon rear windscreen, branch deflector for the bonnet, detachable mirrors, left and right side fender protection at the rear, TÜV certification, and ROPS and FOPS test certificates. Floor protection plates in all forestry module variants, from light to heavy, include all necessary access points for servicing.

Steyr S-Control 8[™] now available

A further on-board highlight is available as an option in Profi series tractors. This innovative Steyr S-Control 8[™] 8-speed powershift transmission has a total of 24 gear ratios in 3 groups, forwards as well as in reverse. It also has a range of automatic functions. These make the tractor not only more



efficient but also appreciably more comfortable. The Profi with Steyr S-Control 8[™] was awarded Machine of the Year 2018 in the Mid Class Tractor category at last year's Agritechnica.

The patented automatic trailer braking system, STEYR S-Brake, provides models in the STEYR CVT, STEYR Terrus CVT, and STEYR Profi CVT with additional stability and safety. This costefficient safety equipment effectively prevents critical operating situations. Until now, it has not been possible to brake trailers when the tractor-trailer combination is decelerated by shifting down gears or taking your foot off the accelerator. As a result, combinations have jack-knifed both on the roads and on forest tracks. The patented STEYR S-Brake now ensures that trailed vehicles can brake using their own foot brake when the combination is decelerated, and that the combinations remain stable and safely under control.
